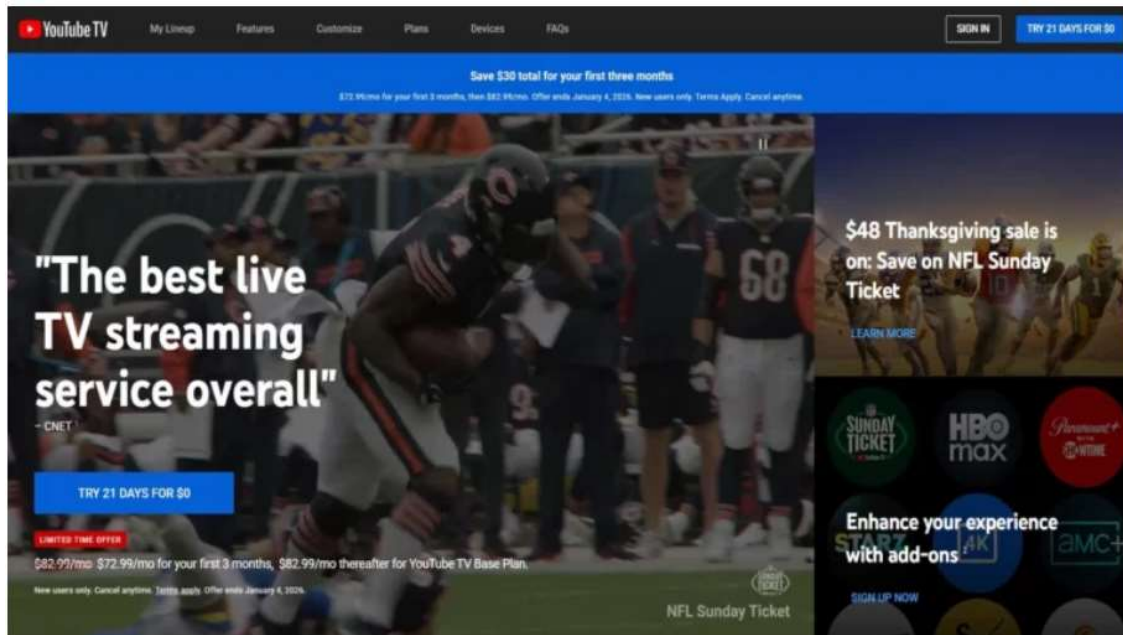

- **New subscribers:**
 - \$150 one-time payment, or
 - 4 monthly payments of \$37.50

No Annual Plan, Only Monthly Billing

There is currently no yearly plan available. Therefore, you pay only month-to-month. If you keep the Base Plan all year, your total comes to:

$$\$82.99 \times 12 = \$995.88$$

This sounds expensive at first. However, compare it to traditional cable bills, which often run \$120 to \$200 a month, plus installation fees. When viewed this way, YouTube TV becomes a cheaper alternative.

Password Sharing Rules

- Streaming on three devices at the same time

However, users must:

- Be above the age of 13
- Live in the same household
- Not be part of another family group

You can easily invite members to join your family group. Each user gets their own login and their own personal DVR library.

Because the service uses your home ZIP code, you need to “check in” from your home area every 3 months if you travel frequently. Otherwise, you may temporarily lose access to local channels.

Offline Viewing

The Base Plan does not allow offline downloads. Yet, when you add 4K Plus, you unlock:

- Unlimited simultaneous streams
- Downloads for offline viewing
- Ultra-high-definition playback

Some premium channels also allow downloads within their individual apps. However, offline viewing inside YouTube TV itself is available only with the 4K Plus add-on.

Is YouTube TV Worth the Price You Pay?

After understanding the full breakdown of YouTube TV’s costs, the next big question is whether the price is justified. The answer depends on your lifestyle, your budget, and your entertainment needs.

When YouTube TV Is a Good Deal

YouTube TV is worth it when:

- You want to replace cable TV
